Avignon HOTEL DE CAMBIS

Since its opening on the ramparts in April 2022, Hotel De Cambis has emerged as a shining star in the heart of Avignon, redefining elegance and artistic design.

he heritage of the Chevaliers De Cambis d'Orsan, a noble family from Avignon's history, is vividly revived within the walls of this establishment, creating a seamless fusion of art, history, and design. The allure of Hotel De Cambis lies not only in its architectural grandeur but in the narrative, it weaves between the pages of history and modern luxury. With a perfect location on the Avignon ramparts, this hotel boasts stunning views that frame the sky and the city itself. Each window is a frame to a story, capturing glimpses of architectural marvels like the Jesuit college chapel and the Calvet Museum's annex.

The creative genius of Julie Gauthron, the interior designer, is evident throughout the hotel. The Orsan bar, with its traditional elements interwoven with modern aesthetics, sets the tone for a captivating experience. The 41 rooms, each with a distinct chromatic mood, engage in a vibrant dialogue of colors. Tinted glass

partitions playfully manipulate space, enhancing dimensions through light and reflection. Premier Cru, Grand Cru and Millésime, (which means Vintage); four different chromatic moods, from golden yellow to terracotta, give each of the rooms its own individual character. In each case, the base hue contrasts with the walls, in a dialogue of colours. Taking inspiration from industrial design, the interior designer has created desks in tubular steel, bedside tables, armchairs and luggage holders in dyed leather, in a vast spectrum of colours. Bespoke furniture and original etchings transform rooms into artistic sanctuaries. In the bathrooms, traditional floor tiles, Sallers pottery and terrazzo rectangles create a genteel atmosphere.

The second-floor breakfast space, offering local flavors against the backdrop of the city's life, encapsulates the hotel's spirit. The buffet, adorned with delights from Provence, invites guests to savor the essence of the region. With a breathtaking view of both the city's daily life and the boundless sky, this space encapsulates the hotel's spirit: a blend of luxury, comfort, and artistic inspiration. Hotel De Cambis is a new landmark on the Cotes du Rhone wine route, and an excuse to revisit the City of the Popes.
